

# MRAC COVID-19 Guidelines for Patrons

---

## Moab Recreation & Aquatics Center Facility Requirements

- Patrons must not enter the facility if they have a fever, cough, or are exhibiting any other COVID-19 symptoms.
- Patrons are asked to utilize the hand sanitizing station immediately upon entering the facility. Face coverings are required indoors in all non-pool areas (lobby and locker room). All patrons will be required to enter the pool through the locker rooms and wash hands and shower before entering the pool area.
- Patrons are encouraged to bring their own pool chairs to avoid using communal poolside equipment.
- Social distancing between user groups must be maintained on the pool deck at all times. Tables will be placed a minimum of ten feet apart by staff and are not to be manipulated by patrons. Face coverings must be worn by patrons on pool deck when social distancing is not feasible.
- Green X-marks will be placed in common queuing areas, including the front desk corridor, and all slides and diving boards. Each user or user group must line up on a green X to maintain proper social distancing.
- For the safety of lifeguards, patrons are asked to not approach the lifeguard stands. Supplementary staff will be available on-site for any questions / concerns that may arise.
- Observe all signage and other regulations enforced by MRAC staff.

*\*\* Currently, there will be no specific restrictions on patron capacity. However, if at any point the MRAC management team feels that pool attendance has grown to a level which no longer allows for proper social distancing, the management team reserves the right to deny further admittance \*\**

## Facility Specifications

- Lap swim, showers, and open swim are the services provided at the MRAC during this time. The fitness room, classroom, and Rascal Room are currently closed.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the facility.

## Utah's Low Risk (yellow) Phase Pool guidelines

- Open plunge operates at a reduced capacity that enables appropriate physical distancing to be maintained between household groups on pool deck.
- Face coverings are worn by individuals on the pool deck when physical distancing is not feasible.
- Lap swimming resumes to normal capacity.
- Swim team and swim lessons are allowed if physical distancing is followed on pool deck.
- Lifeguard training is allowable; safeguards encouraged as much as possible during training including symptom checking of trainees (checklist or verbal), including temperature checks when feasible.
- Maintain signage that encourages physical distancing guidelines to be met at all times.
